

Rules & Regulations

- USTA rules shall govern all play.
- The tournament will be a **combined level of play tournament**.
- Based on entries, matches will be scheduled Saturday, Sunday & Monday.
- All matches will be best two of three sets. The 3rd set will be a 1st to 10 points 'Super Tie-breaker'. No AD scoring until the semi-finals.
- The 12 point tie-breaker will be used at 6-6 with regular scoring.
- Entries may be combined if there are insufficient entries for any one event.
- Partner's name must be on application if you are playing doubles.
- Caveman trophies will be awarded for events.
- Entry fees must accompany applications.
- The Tournament Director/Referee reserves the right to move players to a different level.
- The draw to be posted on the USTA website after 12:00 p.m. on Wednesday, September 1.
- All players will be guaranteed more than one match in each event.
- Please be available as once the draw is made, **there will be no allowances for individual circumstances**.

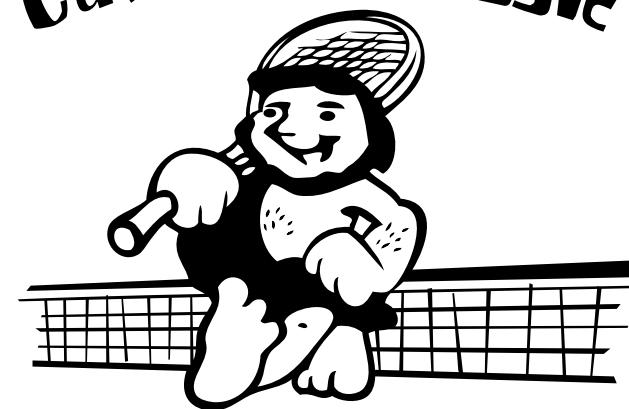
